Kimberley's Feedback from Miss Smith

Kimberley met with Miss Smith and has given the following feedback:

- Miss Smith loves the idea of having a science day. Miss Smith will think about how we can work this into our curriculum.

- Miss Smith loves the idea of having playground problem solvers and she will now think of how we can organise this.
- We will not be changing our school uniform colours. Miss Smith likes the uniform that we have already.
- Miss Smith will have to look into getting fresh juice on a Friday at lunchtime. She will have to look at our food budget to see if we can make this happen.
- Miss Smith said that she will have to seriously consider if we order more playground equipment because children are not taking care of the equipment that we already have. Balls are being purposely kicked on the roof and over the fence.
- Miss Smith loves the idea of having safety posters on the climbing frame. School councillors can make some in our next meeting.

- Miss Smith loves the idea of having maths challenges in the playground as it will help children with their learning. Miss Smith will have a think and see how we can organise this.
