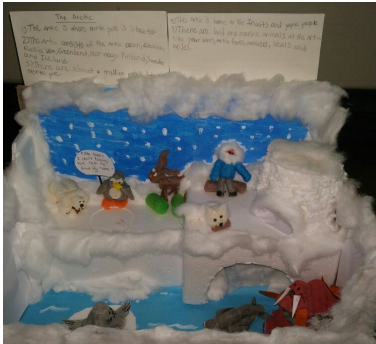


Year 2 Geography Homework Project
