Dear Year 6 Families,

As we near the Year 6 SATs assessments, which take place in May, we felt it would be useful to share some top tips on how to support revision at home.

- Do little and often in terms of work at home. Please double check your child has completed their weekly homework.
- Keep revision light. Going over key skills (times tables, real world mental maths) as you are shopping or cooking is a good way to keep revision light.
- Avoid using past papers.

There are also plenty of free or inexpensive SATs practice materials for parents available. If you're looking to support your child further with revision at home, the information below provides a great starting point.
