On this day you will receive an email informing you of the school place that your child has been allocated for September 2023. With secondary school in mind, I wanted to write to you about some updates for Year 6 going forwards.

Prompt Start

Year 6 children should be at school every morning at **8.50am**. At this time Year 6 children will enter the school straight away and make their way up to their classroom. This will allow additional time for children to complete mental arithmetic and morning reviews.

Morning/Afternoon Boosters

For those who have children that attend our booster sessions, thank you for ensuring children continue to attend before and after school. We have recruited additional staff to deliver these sessions and regular attendance is vital. These sessions are to support pupils working at all levels and are aimed at closing gaps in the children's knowledge.

Staying Safe Online

We would like to highlight the importance of internet safety and the responsible use of apps on mobile devices. It is extremely important to monitor your child's use of devices to ensure they are not exposed to harmful or inappropriate content. We deal with incidents of inappropriate behaviour outside of school which ultimately takes up valuable teaching and learning time. As we have previously stated, most apps have age ratings of 13 years old or above.
