WHO & WHEN	6T - Wednesday 11th October 2023
WHERE	The Royal Observatory in Greenwich
WHY	To deepen our understanding of timezones, longitude and latitude, and how Greenwich came to be the centre of world time.
HOW	We will be travelling by the overground, followed by a short walk. Please ensure your child wears appropriate footwear and clothing for walking and the weather, i.e. waterproof coat and shoes if wet.
COST	£1.00 includes entrance to the observatory and the experience of seeing the Prime Meridian. Please ensure all payments are made at the school office . If you have any issues or queries, please do speak to us and we will be on hand to help.
LUNCH	Children will need a packed lunch. Our catering team can provide children who are entitled to a free school meal with a packed lunch, just let us know on the slip below. Children will need to bring a drink but no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please.
