We want to start out by saying how incredibly proud we are of all the efforts the children have made during their SATs revision in school and at home to help prepare them for their tests in May. As you are aware, when we arrive back to school after the Easter break there will be just **4 weeks** until the tests. The Easter holiday is an optimum time for your child to revise as it is close enough to SATs for them to remember what they have studied. Just to keep their learning brains ticking along, we have spent time creating some revision packs for the Easter holidays.

In their packs children have reading, grammar and maths activities to practise each day. Please help your child to revise by letting them work in a quiet area (if possible) with no distractions. Help them to establish a routine for their revision, e.g. 45 minutes straight after breakfast each day.

From this week onwards, we will also be sharing a report card each week with you (see adjacent image). This card will track the children's scores in their weekly arithmetic and reading extract tests. Please sign this each week and talk to your child about their score to keep them motivated in the final weeks!
