Dear Thomas Fairchild families,

Re: School Uniform and PE Days

I am writing to remind all families of the importance of children wearing the **correct uniform** at school. At Thomas Fairchild we have a uniform policy which all the children must follow. Wearing the correct uniform ensures a sense of pride and respect that sets up children for success.

These are our uniform requirements:

- Navy blue Thomas Fairchild crewneck sweatshirt or cardigan
- Sky blue Thomas Fairchild polo shirt
- Navy blue, black or dark grey school trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Blue gingham dress or navy blue shorts in summer/autumn
- Grey, black or white socks
- Black shoes



For PE, children must come to school on the day that they have their PE lesson wearing:

- White Thomas Fairchild round neck t-shirt
- Navy PE shorts or dark tracksuit bottoms
- Black plimsolls or plain trainers

This term PE days have changed. PE lessons take place on the following days:

Nursery: Friday	Year 3: Monday & Thursday
Reception: Friday	Year 4: Tuesday & Friday
Year 1: Wednesday & Thursday	Year 5: Tuesday & Wednesday
Year 2: Tuesday & Thursday	Year 6: Monday & Wednesday

Except for PE days, children **must wear black shoes** to school. Children are not permitted to wear crocs/sandals at school. Further information about school uniform can be found on our [school website](#).

In addition, children are **not** permitted to wear hooped earrings, or visible necklaces, bracelets or other jewellery. These rules can only be relaxed in a few very specific religious situations. Children who do wear earrings should only wear small, plain studs.
