Re: Wrap Around Provision

I am writing to remind you of our pre-school and after-school provision at Thomas Fairchild. Every day we run a **breakfast club** from 8.00am - 9.00am, which provides children with a nutritious breakfast and a range of creative activities. We also run **Our Space** every day from 3.30pm - 5.55pm, which offers creative play and games led by our caring and experienced play team. Children also are provided with a light meal. For pricing, please see below:

Breakfast Club (8.00-9.00)	Our Space (3.30pm-5.55pm)	Daily Bundle (Breakfast Club and Our Space)
£3 per day	£10 per day (£8 per day pupil premium rate)	£12 per day (£10 pupil premium rate)

All children from age 6 upwards also have access to the local Youth Club and Adventure Playground after school. These are run by external organisations and are free of charge. The details can be found below:

Blue Hut Youth Club (Age Range: 6-14 years): FREE

- Session times are: Mondays (9-14 years) - 4:00pm to 5:30pm , Tuesdays (Girls only, 9-14 years) - 4:00pm to 5:30 pm Wednesdays (9-14 years) - 4:00pm to 7:00pm, Fridays (6-8 years) - 4:00pm to 5:30pm
- Blue Hut is an open access youth club where children can drop in and out as they please.
- Parents must sign a [Home Alone Form](#) indicating if they will be collecting their child, or if the child can travel home alone.
- Snacks and juice are provided, but meals are not.
- Parents must complete the [Membership Form](#) to detail any allergies or medical needs.

Shoreditch Park Adventure Playground (Age Range: 6-15 years. Open daily until 7:00pm): FREE

- Parents must register their child using the [Young Hackney Form](#) and can then collect their child directly from the venue.
- Parents who register directly with Adventure Playground can access the provision anytime during the holidays.
- Snacks are not provided; children must bring their own.

Healthy Snack Advice

- We encourage parents to pack a healthy snack for their children if they are attending these after-school provisions. A nutritious snack will help keep your child energised and engaged in activities.
