Please tell friends and family with pre-school children about our **EYFS Open Morning on Friday 15th November!** Food and fun from 10.30am.

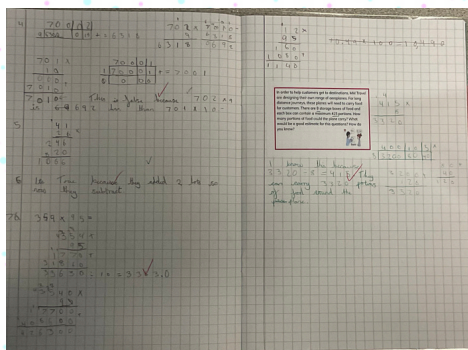
Home Learning Projects
