Re: The Month of Ramadan

The evening of Tuesday 17th February marked the beginning of the holy month of Ramadan and we know that this is an extremely important time for our Muslim families. For families observing Ramadan, we hope that you enjoy this period of peace and reflection.

We understand that some children, particularly those in years 5 and 6 may choose to fast each day, or practise fasting for part of the day. If this is the case, as a school we support children who have chosen to fast during this period. For participating children we will ensure that staff are aware so that we can plan breaks for children if necessary, for example during their PE lesson. For children in younger years, the school will contact you if children inform us they are fasting.

For the period of Ramadan we will also set up a **prayer space** in a quiet part of the school for older children to pray during the lunch break, if they would like to.

Looking ahead to Eid, just like last year, we will be celebrating Eid with a special event. Details of our event will be confirmed closer to the date. In the meantime, if you have any questions at all, please contact the school office.
