Thank you for taking the time to complete our recent parent survey. Below is a summary of the outcomes. Your written feedback was greatly appreciated and has already influenced decisions for the remainder of the year.

100%

say that their child is happy attending Thomas Fairchild.

98%

97%

93%

Next Steps
