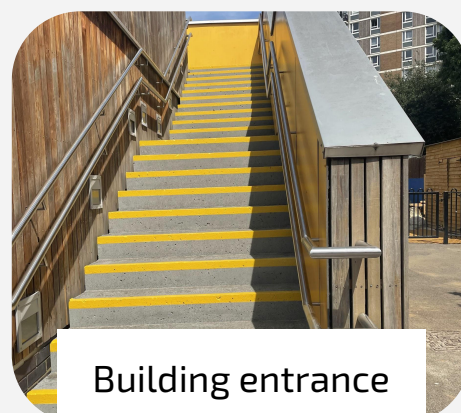
On moving up day you will be shown where you will line up and which door you will use to enter the building. You will already know how to get to the toilets.

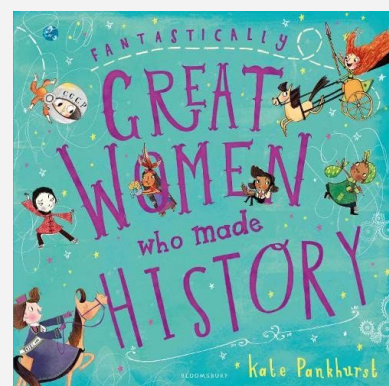


Reading area

Don't worry about moving up into Year 2 - it is loads of fun! Now I'm in Year 2 I feel really grown up.

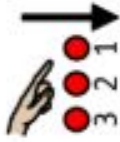
Year 2 is brilliant because you get to read so many funny books. Ask your teacher if you can go to the school library to find even more fun ones.

What is a Holiday Countdown Calendar for?

This calendar can help your child understand how long the holidays lasts for and when they need to come back to school. It can help your child settle back into school quickly as they are prepared for starting school again.

How to use the Holiday Countdown Calendar

1. Show your child the calendar and say 'today there is no school'. Point to the pictures whilst you do this.
2. Encourage your child to cross off the calendar each day.
3. Remind your child there is no school tomorrow by saying 'tomorrow there is no school'.
4. On Wednesday 2nd say 'today there is no school, tomorrow you go back to school'.
